What is Calisthenics?

Calisthenics in a uniquely Australian artistic sport. Calisthenics involves a team of participants learning routines choreographed to music, incorporating elements of dance, gymnastics, singing, acting, marching, ballet, apparatus technique and performance skills.

As a sport, Calisthenics improves coordination, mobility, balance, strength, flexibility and posture as well as fostering self-esteem and team spirit. As an art it encourages an appreciation of music rhythm, the celebration of movement and the excitement of performing on stage. The word Calisthenics comes from the Greek words "kallos" for beauty and "thenos" for strength.

Calisthenics promotes an active body and a healthy mind. Being part of a team develops self-discipline, teamwork, commitment, responsibility, self-esteem, respect and lasting friendships.

The combination of movements and performance skills provides fitness, coordination, rhythm, grace, deportment and confidence.

Club Profile

Laurimar Calisthenics College (LCC) was established in 2012 and is located in Doreen.

All classes are held at two training facilities in Doreen.

- Brookwood Community Centre, 25 Hazel Glen Drive, Doreen
- Plenty Valley Christian College, 840 Yan Yean Road, Doreen

LCC offers Calisthenic classes for:

- Tots starting at 2 years of age
- Tinies 7 years and under
- Sub Juniors 10 years and under
- Juniors 13 years and under
- Intermediates 17 years and under
- Seniors 16 years+
- Masters 26 years +

CaliVic is the state governing body responsible for the development and promotion of Calisthenics within Victoria.

As an affiliated member of CaliVic, LCC complies with all CaliVic policies, procedures and guidelines.

Every participant must be registered with CaliVic in order to be covered by Personal Accident and Public Liability Insurance and to be eligible to enter competitions.

Registration with CaliVic involves a once off yearly fee which covers participants at class, at competitions and at their end of year concert.

CaliVic Performer Registration

Registration with CaliVic involves a once off yearly fee with Insurance for our pupils while in class, at competitions and at their end of year concert.

Schedule of costs for 2025

At LCC we run by school terms however some classes are scheduled during school holidays.

The following cost is per pupil which includes:-

- class fees
- costume and equipment hire
- competition entry fees
- CaliVic affiliation fees

We offer a sibling discount as shown below. We do not refund missed classes or if a pupil leaves mid term, they will forfeit their term fees*. Any pupils starting during the year will have fees calculated accordingly.

Club Uniform

What to bring and wear to class

Calisthenics is performed in bare feet so we do not wear shoes in our classes.

Black leotard, black footless leggings or tights. Tights are optional in the warmer weather.

Black crossover top or wrap must be worn in the cooler weather. Items can be purchased at Kmart, Target or dance shops.

Hair is to be tied back off the face, no dangly earrings or jewellery to be worn to class.

Each pupil is required to bring a bottle of water to every class. Please label this with their name.

Competitions / Performances

Competitions are a fun and rewarding way for our performers to highlight their routines that they have working hard on all year.

The performers develop wonderful confidence, teamwork and technical skills.

Most of our competitions are in Melbourne's surrounding suburbs. Competition dates are released by CaliVic at the end of May each year. These dates will be communicated as soon as we receive them.

Competitions are held between July – October and it is **compulsory** for all Laurimar performers to attend all competitions.

Tots – perform 2 items at the Annual Concert only (no competitions)
Tinies – 3 competitions per year
Sub Juniors – 4 competitions per year
Juniors – 4 competitions per year
Intermediates – 4 competitions per year
Seniors – 4 competitions per year

Some sections may enter the Royal South Street Competitions to be held in Ballarat in October. This will be in addition to the competitions mentioned above and will be discussed with each section by the end of term 1.

Attendance

At LCC it is an expectation that performers attend classes on a weekly basis. As this is a team based sport attendance is the key to the success and progress of the individual and most importantly the team.

We hope that you can support us to achieve this.
